– San Francisco Opera General Director David Gockley today announced the creation of the first permanent high-definition broadcast-standard video production facility installed in any American opera house. The Korret Media Suite gives San Francisco Opera the permanent capability to generate a high-definition, multi-camera live feed of the stage for many uses including simulcasts and a new program, OperaVision. Located on the fifth floor of the War Memorial

Opera House, the media suite features on-site video and audio post-production facilities which allow the Company to produce and edit radio broadcasts in-house. Technology in the media suite also enables the Company to consider future ideas such as expanded podcasting, live streaming, DVD production and many other electronic media possibilities." Diversified Systems was chosen to integrate this unique High Definition facility. DSI provided engineering,

consulting and design services, and followed-up with the installation in the historic War Memorial Opera Building.

The Opera also announced plans to bring opera to the ballpark when on September 28, 2007, it will produce a live, free simulcast of Saint-Saëns's biblical epic *Samson and Delilah* at San Francisco Giants' AT&T Park, on the new 3200 square foot 32-by-9 scoreboard. Coincidentally, Diversified Systems integrated the high definition control room at AT&T Park.
